

RESOLUTION NO. 387

AWARDING BID TO DRILL A NEW WELL NEAR 19th & CASCADE STREETS

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has been working closely in conjunction with it's engineer, Columbia Engineering, in preparing the necessary Plans and Specifications to drill a new water source for District use; and

WHEREAS, said Plans and Specifications have been disbursed to eight prospective well drillers in the North Central Washington area in order to obtain informal bids; and

WHEREAS, two bids were received from Glessner Well Drillers of Mansfield, Washington and Dietrich Well Drillers of Wenatchee in the following amounts, to include Washington State Sales Tax:

Glessner Well Drillers - \$9,495.20


Dietrich Drillers - 19,314.00

WHEREAS, when bids were received and opened, it was determined that the bid of Glessner was a "non-responsive bid" because he neglected to fill in a bid amount under "Pump and Piping Setup" as well as "Test Pumping the Well", together with the fact that he could not produce a Bid Bond, as called for in the Specifications; and

WHEREAS, after reviewing the Specifications further with the District's legal council and it's engineer, it was recommended by both that the bid be awarded to Dietrich Drilling Company who did comply with all documentations as called for in the specifications.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT does hereby award the bid in the amount of \$19,314.00 including state sales tax, to Dietrich Drilling Company.
