

RESOLUTION NO. 393

DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO INSTALL A CARRIER PIPE AND RELATED FITTINGS  
UNDER IRRIGATION CANAL

WHEREAS, THE East Wenatchee Water District, has included in it's 1992 budget to install approximately 1,400 feet of 12" water main on Sunset Highway and,

WHEREAS, the Wenatchee Reclamation maintains an irrigation canal at approximately 31st Street and Sunset Highway where said water main must cross under the Canal and,


WHEREAS, having discussed with the Manager of the Wenatchee Reclamation when water will be turned into the canal and determined that approximately April 6th, is their target date and,

WHEREAS, the Water District was informed that the Wenatchee Reclamation desires a minimum of 28 days for the concrete to cure, once it has been poured in place for safety factors and,


WHEREAS, having evaluated all factors with the District's Engineer and determined that it was virtually impossible to prepare the necessary plans and specifications for public bid within a time period of less than 30 days, and time is of essence to the Water District to complete the canal crossing prior to the water being turned on.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that Resolution No. 393 is hereby declared an emergency and further authorizes the manager to proceed with Water District personnel to accomplish the necessary tasks involved in installing the necessary pipe, valves and related fittings to complete the job.
