

RESOLUTION NO. 399

RECINDING RESOLUTION NO. 238 - STEEL TOE SHOES

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has established, by Resolution #238 which was adopted on May 1st, 1978, whereby the District would contribute \$45.00 toward the purchase of steel toe safety shoes for district employees who are engaged in the day to day operations with the district.

WHEREAS, that amount was increased to \$65.00 because of increased costs to purchase said shoes and,

WHEREAS, THE District has checked with the Department of Labor and Industries and learned that steel toe shoes is no longer a requirement in our employees line of work and,


WHEREAS, this matter was previously discussed with the Board of Commissioners to eliminate this expense in preparing the District's 1993 Budget and was unanimously agreed upon by the Board of Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE by it HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, effective January 1st, 1993, the District will no longer participate in the purchase of steel toe shoes for it's employees and Resolution #238 is hereby rescinded.
