Resolution No. 401

WHEREAS, the aquifers that supply potable water to the majority of the population of the East Wenatchee Water District customers are susceptible to contamination due to the lack of a confining soil layer between the ground surface and the ground water table, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Health is currently developing a Wellhead Protection Program that will be State mandated in July of 1993, and

WHEREAS, local agencies are working together in an effort to obtain grant moneys in an attempt to partially fund this program, and


WHEREAS, wellhead protection raises multi-jurisdictional issues that need to be addressed, and

WHEREAS, local agencies have been working jointly on a grant application for the development of a Wellhead Protection Program, and

WHEREAS, the agencies involved are knowledgeable of the tasks and responsibilities that will be incurred during the wellhead protection process, and

WHEREAS, Douglas County Planning has agreed to act as lead agency for this proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the East Wenatchee Water District Board of Commissioners that a commitment to support the Douglas County Wellhead Protection Program and grant effort of the local agencies in the East Wenatchee area is hereby Authorized.
