OFFICIALLY ACCEPTING EMPLOYEE HANDBOOK

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has never developed or written an official handbook to present new employees when they are hired by the District either on a part-time or full time basis, and


WHEREAS, this matter was discussed with the District by the State Examiners Office during the exit conference in September, 1994, and it was determined that this was a requirement that all districts must have an employee handbook as part of the requirements in complying with their audit, and

WHEREAS, the District was in the process of writing a handbook at the time of their audit, but had not finalized the necessary material to have the book printed for review or accepted by the Board of Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, the District has now compiled all necessary information so as to comply with the State Examiners audit, the material has been reviewed by District legal counsel and written in a generic way, some of the guidelines and procedures for current and future employees of the District.


