

RESOLUTION NO. 432

AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 310 AND RE-ESTABLISHING SHUT-OFF & CALL OUT CHARGES

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District personnel is called out from time to time during working hours to turn-on water that has been shut-off for non-payment, as well as after hours and on holidays, as well as weekends and,

WHEREAS, the previous rates charges were not commensurate with the actual cost incurred for such services rendered and the "stand-by" or on-call employee is called out periodically to render a service that may not be related to water district business and is a convenience to the customer,

NOW THEREFORE, be it HEREBY RESOLVED, that effective immediately the following procedures will apply: A delinquent notice is mailed to the customer specifying a specific date the account is to be paid. If no response is received, a shut-off tag is hung on the door, which automatically adds \$15.00 to the delinquent account. If the account is not paid, the service is terminated. A charge of \$30.00 will be accessed to turn the service back on during working hours, 8:00 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. or \$50.00 after hours, to include weekends and holidays.
