

RESOLUTION NO. 444

**ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION TO CROSS UNDER
IRRIGATION CANAL**

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has budgeted approximately \$27,000 as part of their Capital Improvement Projects for 1996 to cross under an irrigation canal with a 12" water main to better serve a certain pressure zone so additional fire flow can be obtained, and

WHEREAS, upon discussing this crossing with the Wenatchee Reclamation District, it was learned that a new 42" irrigation water main was being installed by the Reclamation District, with a time provision of said installation to be completed on April 1st, and

WHEREAS, the contractor installing the 42" irrigation main is committed to complete the project by April 1st, 1996, and as the contractor is already on the job site, time becomes a factor for the Water District in getting the 12" water main installed, and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications have been prepared by our engineer so quotes might be obtained from contractors on the District's Small Works Roster, however, it is very unlikely that the District can obtain quotes from other contractors that are capable of doing the canal crossing, because of the complexities involved and it would appear that it is the most prudent thing to obtain a quote from the contractor on site to install the canal crossing, and

WHEREAS, the District's engineer has estimated the project to cost \$48,913.00 to include materials and a quote has been obtained from Seland Construction Company, the contractor currently installing the 42" water main to install the pipe and all fittings for a total of \$39,800, excluding sales tax.

NOW THEREFORE IT BE HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District, the manager is hereby authorized to contact Seland Construction Company and instruct them to proceed with the canal crossing for their quote of \$39,800, excluding sales tax.

ADOPTED this 28th day of March 1996, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
