

RESOLUTION NO. 456

**AMENDS RESOLUTION #366 BY AUTHORIZING AN
INCREASE IN THE DISTRICT'S SERVICE CHARGE
ON "NON-SUFFICIENT FUND CHECKS"**

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District is a public entity that must receive a large amount of personal checks from the general public in paying their water bills, and

WHEREAS, a certain amount of these checks are returned by the banks, and

WHEREAS, the cost of processing these checks to the District is costly and unfair to the other regular East Wenatchee Water District customers, it is deemed necessary to review the current charge of \$10.00 per NSF check and re-establish a new assessment to cover the work hours involved, and

WHEREAS, the District is below the minimum charge being assessed currently State wide, it is determined the new service charge of \$20.00 will be assessed to customers who's checks are returned.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District, that effective January 16, 1997, all checks returned from various banks because non-sufficient funds, shall be assessed a charge of \$20.00.

ADOPTED, this 16th day of January 1997, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
