

RESOLUTION NO. 495

AWARD 24-INCH REGIONAL TRANSMISSION WATER MAIN

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District having complied with R.C.W. 57.08.050 in calling for bids to install water mains and other system improvements to the District's water system and;

WHEREAS, the projects are identified in the District's 1996 Comprehensive Water System Plan and;

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared by the District's engineer for said projects, and the District will provide 14,625 feet of 24-inch push-on joint and 3,000 feet of 8-inch push-on joint ductile iron pipe, and the contractor will furnish all other pipe, fittings, valves, and all other items necessary to complete each job as called for in the contract documents with the projects generally described as follows:

24-inch Regional Transmission Main. This project will consist of the constructing of approximately 16,200 feet of 24-inch diameter push-on and restraint joint pipe, 200 feet of 12-inch diameter push-on joint pipe, 3,000 feet of 8-inch diameter push-on joint pipe and miscellaneous pipe for tie-ins, and a bored irrigation ditch crossing.

WHEREAS, the District received eleven bids to install said water main as follows:

WHEREAS, the Engineer's estimate is \$1,686,404, sales tax excluded.

WHEREAS, the lowest bidder, Kar-Vel Construction, sent a letter to the District requesting that their bid be withdrawn due to a materials bidding error and;


WHEREAS, having reviewed all the bid documents with the District's engineer, it appears that all bids are responsive bids, and therefore it is recommended that the second lowest bid in the amount of \$1,255,809.85, excluding sales tax, be awarded to Olalla Hills Excavation. The General Manager is authorized to do all acts necessary to carry out the contract award as a result of this bid and;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, that the low bid in the amount of one million, two hundred and fifty-five thousand, eight hundred and nine dollars and eighty-five cents is hereby awarded to Olalla Hills Excavation of Olalla, WA.
