

RESOLUTION NO. 571

**AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 453 BY AUTHORIZING AN
INCREASE IN THE DISTRICT'S PLANT INVESTMENT FEE.**

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District adopted the above resolution on January 2, 1997, authorizing a Plant Investment Fee on the sale of all water meters, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature passed substitute Senate Bill #6013 effective July 23, 1989, whereby a Water or Sewer District is entitled to charge for a customer to connect to that system, and


WHEREAS, the Connection Charge shall be the pro-rata share of the cost of the existing facilities and planned future improvements for the next ten years and other directly attributable costs borne by the District (but, those costs shall not include portions of the system which have been contributed to the district), and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners instructed the Manager to have the District's Engineer update the District's Plant Investment Fee charges based on standard engineering practice, and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has reviewed the updated Plant Investment Fee calculation and agrees that it should be increased according to ATTACHMENT A, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the East Wenatchee Water District, having reviewed the updated Plant Investment Fee calculations set forth on ATTACHMENT A, and concurring with the recommendations of the Manager and Engineer, hereby approve and adopt the Plant Investment Fees set forth on ATTACHMENT A for the District effective May 1, 2006, subject to the following terms and conditions: (1)The District will allow a customer to purchase a meter at the pre-May 1, 2006 Plant Investment Fee rate, if such customer (A)applied for service to purchase the meter prior to May 1, 2006, and (b)activates the meter applied for by December 31, 2006; And (2)if a Customer fails to activate any pre-paid purchased meter by December 31, 2006 the District agrees to refund any Plant Investment and meter fees paid by such customer and the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Manager to exercise his discretion based on sound engineering judgment to determine the fees(Plant Investment and Meter) to be charged by the District for meters in excess of one and one-half inches in size.

ADOPTED, this 1st day of March, 2006, by the Board of Commissioners of the East Wenatchee Water District, Douglas County, Washington at a regular meeting thereof.
