RESOLUTION NO. 577

ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM ON THE SALE OF WATER METERS
ON 11TH ST NE AND ALVIN CT.

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has maximized the hydraulic capacity of the 2"OD steel main in N. Alvin Ct from 11th St NE north, and

WHEREAS, basic hydraulic calculations would limit the number of equivalent residential units to 20 ERU's on a dead end 2" OD steel pipe, and


WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District has been advised by its consulting engineers that the District has maximized the current hydraulic capacity of the 2" OD steel main in and at Alvin ct running from 11th St NE extending to the North (the "Area"), and

WHEREAS, it appears that the existing system capacity has been committed with the addition of new multi-family units in the Area given the hydraulic limitations on the number of equivalent residential units at 20 ERU's for the system as it currently exists in the Area, and


WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners hereby find and deem it to be in the best interest of the District to impose a moratorium on new service to the Area, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the District that a moratorium be placed on new service to the Area to be effective on and after the date of the Resolution.
