**RESOLUTION NO. 630**

**AMEND RESOLUTION No. 543--DELINQUENT CHARGES AND  
COLLECTION POLICIES**

WHEREAS, RCW 57.08.081(3) allows the District to adopt by Resolution, penalties of not more than 10 percent of delinquent rates and charges, and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have established the addition of a 10% penalty on the delinquent balance, if more than 30 days past due, and

WHEREAS, if a current rate payer moves from one location to another location the District can transfer the old balance to the new account, and


WHEREAS, if a customer has had a history of being late with payments for water service supplied then the District, at its discretion, can require payment in full prior to approving the new service account, and

WHEREAS, if a customer who is a renter of the property has a history of being late with payments and/or has been shut off for non-payment, the District, at its discretion, can put the account into the owner's name after proper notification is made to the owner. Proper notification is defined as written notice with 14 days advance notice, and


WHEREAS, the District will send out a bi-monthly billing with the balance due within 30 days of the billing date; at 31 days the 10% penalty described herein will be added; at 60 days a water bill will be mailed out with a message on the bill stating that the bill is past due and scheduled for shut-off. This billing is the FINAL NOTICE and service may be terminated within 4-11 days thereafter. Payment is due in full at the time of shut off, and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that these policies will be adopted, enforced and followed by the District immediately.
