

**RESOLUTION NO. 635**

**AWARD 2012 1170 ZONE WATERMAIN EXTENSION**

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District pursuant to R.C.W. 57.08.050 called for bids in connection with the 1170 Zone Watermain Extension project generally described as follows:

Construction of approximately 1,850 feet of 12-inch watermain, water service and appurtenances. 12-inch ductile iron pipe will be provided by the Water District, and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared by the District's engineer for the above described project and the successful contractor will furnish all the necessary equipment and materials to complete each job as called for in the project contract documents, and

WHEREAS, the District received five bids (prices include sales tax) to install said water main facilities as follows:


Prazer Construction	\$82,156.00
Hurst Construction	\$92,268.76
Selland Construction	\$100,419.50
Pipkin Construction	\$103,473.32
Allemandi Construction	\$126,310.48

WHEREAS, having reviewed all the bid documents with the District's engineer, it appears that all bids are responsive bids, and therefore it is recommended by the District's engineer that the lowest responsible bid be awarded to Prazer Construction in the amount of \$82,156.00, and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that the lowest responsible bid from Prazer Construction in the amount of eighty two thousand, one hundred fifty six dollars and zero cents is hereby accepted and a contract for the project will be executed with Prazer Construction of East Wenatchee Washington.

BE IT ALSO HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, the General Manager is authorized to do all acts necessary to effectuate the Resolution adopted herein.
