

RESOLUTION NO. 703

AWARD 2017 STEEL MAIN REPLACEMENTS

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District pursuant to R.C.W. 57.08.050 called for bids in connection with the 2017 Steel Main Replacements generally described as follows:

Construction of approximately 4,300 lineal feet of primarily 8-inch diameter ductile iron water main, isolation valves, fire hydrants, connections to the existing water system, and connection to existing customer service lines. Existing customer water service vaults and setters will be reused in-place. Also included is pavement restoration for trenches, plus half street and full street pavement overlays. Work will occur on North Nevada Avenue from Grant Road to 3rd St NE, South Iowa Avenue from 2nd St SE to 4th St SE, and South Houston Avenue from 1st St SE to 3rd St SE.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared by the District's engineer for the above described project and the successful contractor will furnish all the necessary equipment and materials to complete each job as called for in the project contract documents, and

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2017, the District received three bids (prices include sales tax) to install said facilities as follows:


Pipkin Construction	\$1,022,663.60
Advantage Dirt	\$1,025,035.43
Hurst Construction	\$1,104,972.62

WHEREAS, having reviewed all the bid documents with the District's engineer, it appears that all bids are responsive bids, and therefore it is recommended by the District's engineer that the lowest responsible bid be awarded to Pipkin Construction. for the amount of \$1,022,663.60, and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that the lowest responsible bid from Pipkin Construction. in the amount of one million, twenty two thousand, six hundred sixty three dollars and sixty cents is hereby accepted and a contract for the project will be executed with Pipkin Construction of East Wenatchee, Washington.

BE IT ALSO HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, the General Manager is authorized to do all acts necessary to effectuate the Resolution adopted herein.

Breckenridge 2 Phase II


