

RESOLUTION NO. 754

AWARD 10<sup>TH</sup> ST NE BOOSTER PUMP STATION

WHEREAS, the East Wenatchee Water District pursuant to R.C.W. 57.08.050 called for bids in connection with the 2021 10<sup>th</sup> St NE Booster Pump Station generally described as follows:

Work to be performed includes: construction of a domestic water pump station including two 75 hp and two 100 hp vertical turbine pumps, 1,400 square foot CMU building, mechanical, electrical, sitework, and the installation of approximately 500 lineal feet of 12-inch ductile iron water main.

WHEREAS, plans and specifications were prepared by the District's Engineer for the above-described project and the successful contractor will furnish all the necessary equipment and material to complete each job as called for in the project contract documents, and

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2021, the District received one bid to install said facilities as follows:

WHEREAS, having reviewed all the bid documents with the District's Engineer, it appears that all bids are responsive bids and therefore it is recommended by the District's Engineer that the lowest responsible bid be awarded to KRCI for the amount of \$2,224,049.00, and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT that the lowest responsible bid from KRCI in the amount of two million, two hundred twenty-four thousand and forty-nine dollars and zero cents be hereby accepted and a contract for the project will be executed with KRCI of East Wenatchee, Washington.

BE IT ALSO HEREBY RESOLVED, by the BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS of the EAST WENATCHEE WATER DISTRICT, the General Manager is authorized to do all acts necessary to effectuate the Resolution adopted herein.
